Before we even started our trip, we were already exhausted from cleaning our rental house and packing our belongings for storage. With a layover and driving, the trip was around 24 hours. We were exhausted by the time we arrived in the States, but we thank the Lord, He helped us make it safely. We were in New Zealand for two and a half years, so we have to be out of the country for at least that period of time. Please pray that the Lord will give us direction on what to do here in the States while we are waiting to return to New Zealand. We stand in awe at how the Lord ordered our steps and opened doors of ministry for us. With His help over 16,000 tracts and thousands of New Testaments were given out. When we moved into our first house, we met four families that lived on our street. For around two years those four families have faithfully attended Bible Study and Bible class monthly. When we moved to our second home more children began attending. We held a monthly church service and youth night as well. We saw spiritual growth in the young people who attended youth night, and we were able to baptize one of them before we left. Also, we were able to be involved in nursing home ministries as well as leading a youth choir, teaching Sunday School and youth class at the Ethiopian church that sponsored us for our visa.
